2009 Competitive Winterball

1. The District would be providing 2 distinct Winterball programs:
 - a. An instructional league very similar to what we have done in the past that will be administered by the League
 - b. A competitive program administered by the District
2. Would have programs in the following age groups:
 - a. 14 & U (Juniors): Base path will be at 60/90
 - b. 13 & U (Juniors just coming up): Base path will be at 54/80),
 - c. 12 & U (Majors): Base path will be at 46/60
 - d. 11 & U (AAA): Base path will be at 46/60
 - e. Open to Little League Players only
3. Each League would have 1 or 2 teams in the Competitive Winterball Program
 - a. Teams will be provided to the District by the Leagues
 - i. District will charge \$100 per team. This cost will cover the administration of the program and for the post season tournament championship T-shirts/hats
 - b. Coaches could put together their own team under the direction of that League and enter into the program
4. Players would need to come from within the League Boundaries
 - a. We could use combined play
 - i. Be sure to involve the Player Agent
5. Pitch count rules Using Option 2
6. Will play with a continuous batting order in all Divisions
7. Schedule for Sundays only so as not to compete with the other Winter sports
 - a. Will schedule a 10 game season
 - b. Will schedule double headers where field availability allows
 - i. Where field availability will allow, Managers can schedule one of the games during the week
 - c. May play home games at another leagues field
8. Umpires will be scheduled by the District

9. Will have a time limit

- a. 12 and Under: no new inning after 1 ½ hours
- b. 13 and over: no new inning after 2 hours
- c. 15 minutes between games

10. Allow time for travelling Tournaments

- a. 2 designated weekends will be selected to allow time to play in a travel ball tournament: to be determined late
 - i. Each Manager will need to get his own insurance and equipment to use in the non-Little League event
- b. We will be having post season Tournament at the end of the regular scheduled games
 - i. The 10 scheduled games will be used for seating in the post season tournament

11. Important dates:

- a. Each League will need to provide a list of teams to the District by August 24, 2009
 - i. This will allow for time to develop the schedule
- b. Will start the season on the week of September 12, 2009
- c. End the regular season on October 31, 2009
 - i. May adjust these dates after determining the “dark” weeks
- d. Season end tournament will begin the week of November 7th
 - i. This too may be adjusted after determining the “dark” weeks
