2010 Competitive Winterball

1. There will be 2 levels of Winterball offered in District 68 this year:
 - a. A League program: administered by the Leagues
 - b. A competitive program: administered by the District
2. League Program
 - a. Administered by the individual Leagues
 - i. Inter-leagues established by the individual leagues
 - ii. Schedules made by the Inter-league group
 - iii. Age groupings as in the spring
 1. Kids will play up to next year's age group
 2. 11 year olds cannot play in the Junior Divisions
 - iv. Games played according to Spring Rules
 1. Keep score
 2. Games played at a "laid-back" philosophy
 3. Umpires provided by the Leagues
 - v. Post season play determined by each Inter-league group
3. Competitive
 - a. Administered by the District
 - b. One Team per league
 - i. Possibly combine 2 leagues to form 1 team
 1. Be the better kids in the League
 2. More than 2 teams from a League must be approved by the district
 - ii. Coaches could put together their own team under the direction of that League and enter into the program
 1. Kids must come from within the League boundaries without Combined Play Form

- c. Age groups:
- i. 14 & U (Returning Juniors): Base path will be at 60/90
 - ii. 13 & U (Juniors just coming up): Base path will be at 54/80
 - iii. 12 & U (11 year old Major players returning to Majors): Base path will be 50/70
 - iv. 11 & U (AAA players expected to move up to Majors): Base path will be at 46/60
 - v. 10 & U (AA/AAA players expected to play AAA): Base path will be at 46/60
 - vi. Open to Little League Players only; can sign up new players
- d. District will provide the schedule
- i. Will schedule a 6 week season
 1. Will have an occasional Double-header
 2. Win/loss record determines tournament seeding
 3. Schedule for Sundays only so as not to compete with the other Winter sports
 4. Managers can reschedule one of the games during the week where fields are available and both teams approve
- e. Umpires provided by the District with Managers supervision
- f. Will have a post game tournament
- g. District will charge \$100 per team. This cost will cover the administration of the program and for the post season tournament championship T-shirts
- i. Registration Form will be due to the District by August 20th. 2010**
